For parents of children 6-12 years who are open to CAMHS. This is the treatment course recommended by NICE guidelines

as a first line intervention following diagnosis - so is great for all parents whose children have either a diagnosis of ADHD or are awaiting assessment.

Please Note: This is an evidenced based programme so parents are expected to commit to the full 12 weeks in order for it

to be effective, as each session is aimed to address specific issues in a timely way. Assessments are conducted prior to the

programme to start to identify parents individual goals and what they want to achieve through the programme. This ensures that certain aspects of the course can be tailored to meet the specific needs of each parent.
